From beginners to seasoned weekend warriors and full-time professionals, each Off-Road Series event welcomes mountain bikers of all experience levels with three different length courses challenging the mind and body as well as delivering awe-striking views of nature's beauty. Each event has its own unique flavor and character thanks to the vibrant host cities that value the importance of healthy living and outdoor recreation.

"The Oz Trails Off-Road is more than just about Bentonville, it's about all of Northwest Arkansas, as the region boasts trails suited for all skill levels," said Kalene Griffith, Visit Bentonville President, and CEO.
