In order to make sure everyone at the 18th annual 24 Hours in the Old Pueblo p/b Tucson Medical Center has a good day on the bike, keep in mind these friendly passing etiquette guidelines:

- For those out there just cruising, please be mindful of faster riders and yield when a passing rider calls out "on your left" or "on your right".
- Please don't speed up when someone wishes to pass, just let them by as soon as it's safe.
- For those passing, be vocal but be courteous. Shout "rider back" well ahead of
 your approach to give the rider plenty of advance notice. Then as you get closer,
 if they haven't pulled over, give another friendly "on your left" or "on your
 right", and after passing, be sure to say thanks and shout some positive words
 of encouragement.
