Packet Pickup & Start Times

All participants are required to complete an accident waiver & release of liability form. All participants under 18 are required to have a legal guardian to co-sign their waiver; this [Junior Waiver](#) must be on paper (scans or photos are not acceptable) and can be turned in at packet pickup.

Rider ID, and proof of Covid vaccination or negative Covid test results are required at packet pick-up. A friend/family member is allowed to pick up another rider's packet when a copy of the rider's ID and proof of Covid vaccination/negative Covid test results are provided, and a waiver has been completed.

El Yucateco Fat Tire Criteriums

Trail & Passing Etiquette



All event participants are asked to help keep the singletrack single by staying within the singletrack tread, passing in areas that are safe and responsible and by not cutting corners.

Participants that need to dismount from their bicycles should move their bike and themselves off the trail only if they can do so in a manner that doesn't impact the soil or vegetation.

When passing or being passed, please communicate clearly ("on your left" or "may I pass when you're ready?") so as to assure a safe and successful environment for both parties.

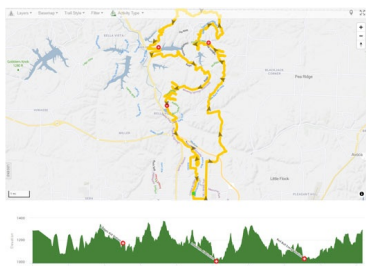

Course Details



Ozark 15 Cut-Off Time (Friday)

Riders have roughly 3.5 hours to complete the course. Course support will be closed at 5:30p on Friday. If the director anticipates you may not make this time limit, you may be asked to reroute in the most direct manner to the finish.

Ozark 30, 50 & Pro 50 Cut-Off Times (Saturday)

In order to ensure riders return to the finish before course support (Medical, Traffic, Police, Comm, Volunteers) ends at 4:00p, the following cutoffs have been established:

- Ozark 50 riders arriving after 11:00a at the Pinyon/Ledges Aid Station (14.8 miles in) will be asked to continue on the Ozark 30 route and will be considered a DNF.
- Ozark 50 riders arriving after 1:45p at the Veterans Memorial Aid Station (38.8 miles in) will be asked to remain on the Razorback Greenway to Crystal Bridges to regain the course and will be considered a DNF.
- Ozark 30 riders arriving after 1:45p at the Veterans Memorial Aid Station (23.6 miles in) will be asked to remain on the Razorback Greenway to Crystal Bridges to regain the course and will be considered a DNF.

Start Line Redemption Opportunity - Participants cut off by the race director will be considered a DNF (Did Not Finish), along with DNFs due to medical issues and mechanical failures. DNF riders may receive 50% Off of the following year's OZ Trails Off-Road registration as a start line redemption opportunity.

All DNF riders are expected to report to the Epic Rides tent to notify an Epic Rides crew member that they are no longer on the course.

Hammer Nutrition Aid Stations



There will be up to 3 Hammer Nutrition Aid Stations on the courses and one Hammer Nutrition Aid Station at the finish line throughout the weekend:

- Ozark 15 Fun Ride: Slaughter Pen Aid Station
- Ozark 30 backcountry course: Pinyon Creek Aid Station, Veterans Memorial Aid Station
- Ozark 50 backcountry course: Pinyon Creek Aid Station, Lake Ann Aid Station, Veterans Memorial Aid Station



Each Aid station on the course is equipped with Hammer Nutrition products (incl. Hammer gel & Heed) plus cookies, pretzels, oranges, and yes, pickles.

BONUS: Get a free hammer flask and top it off with 5 servings of Hammer Gel in the bike & gear expo before your ride!.

If a rider prefers a different hydration mix or energy drink, we encourage them to bring their own and mix with the water provided on the route.

Aid stations are roughly 10 miles apart; plan to start the event with a full hydration pack and plenty of food to get to Aid 1.
